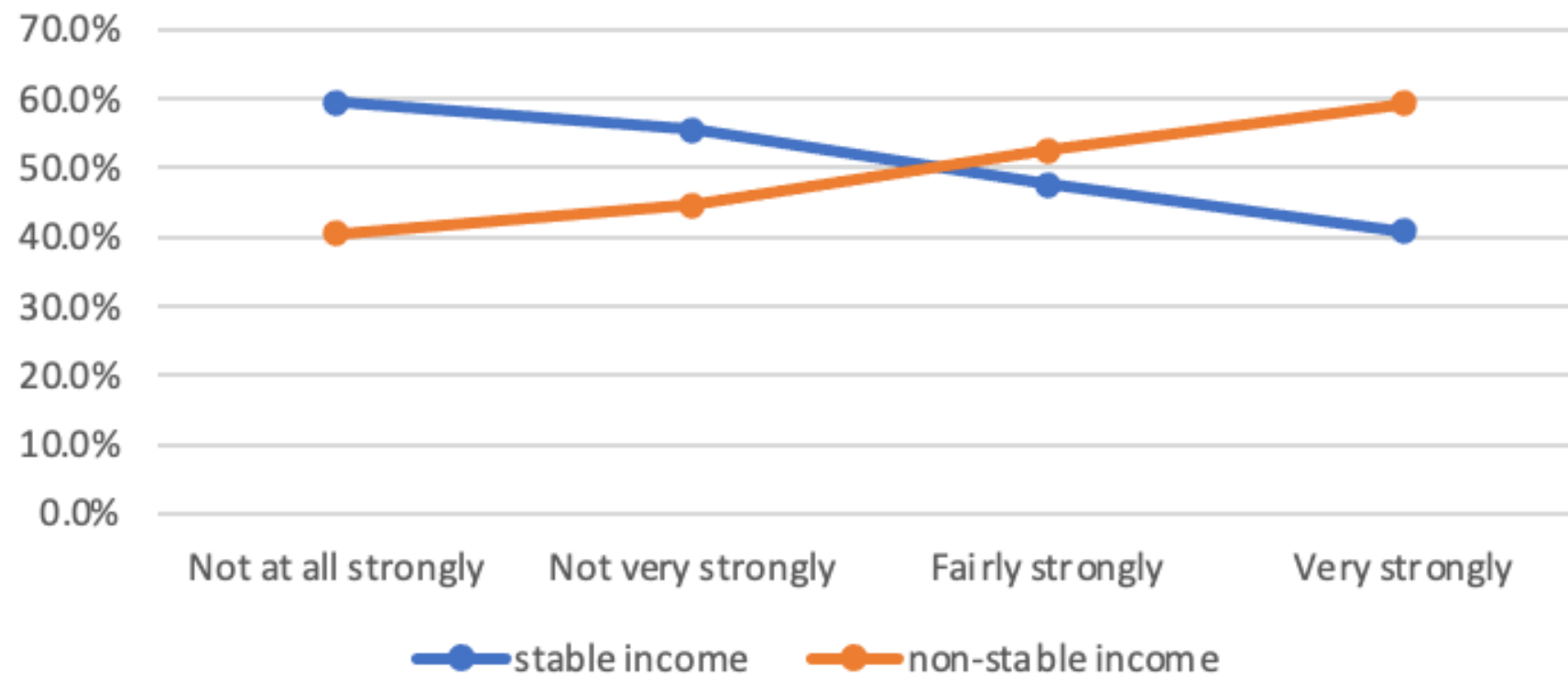

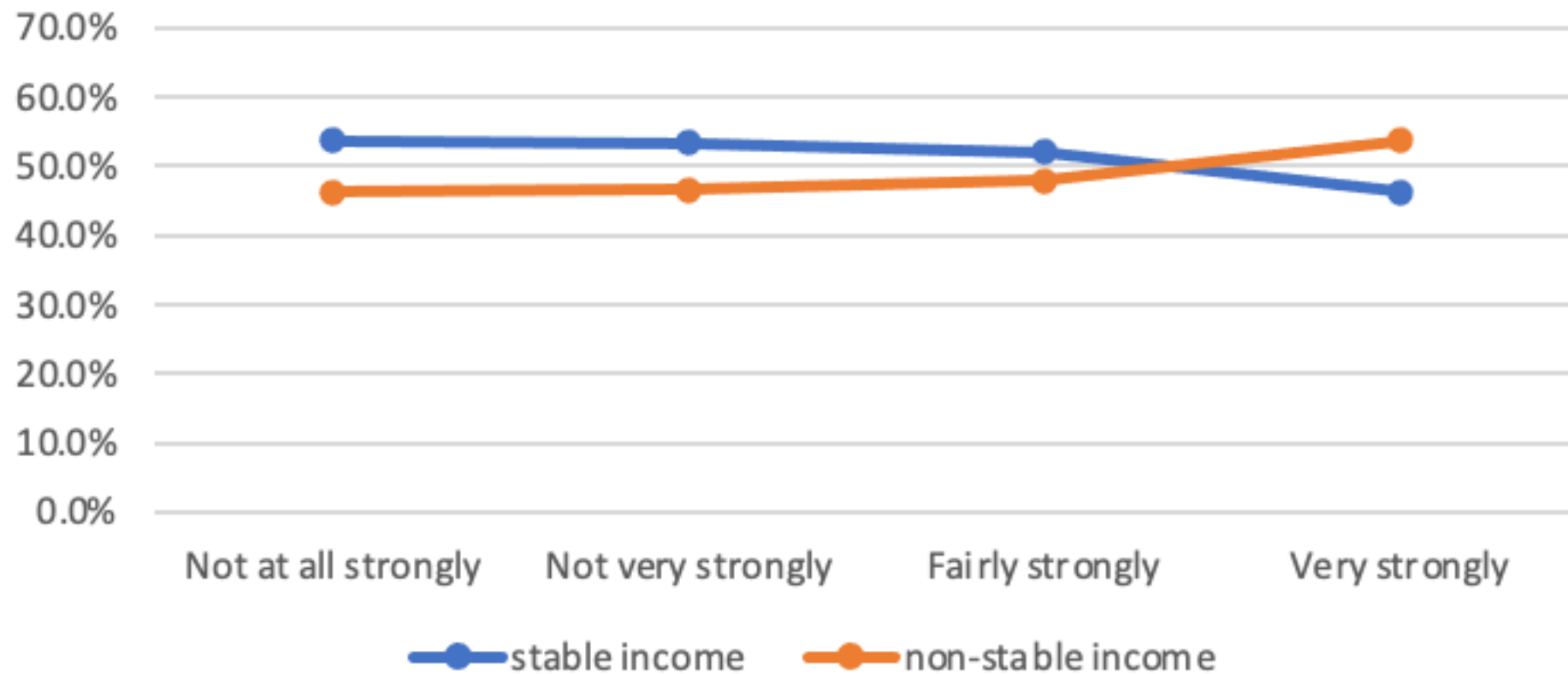

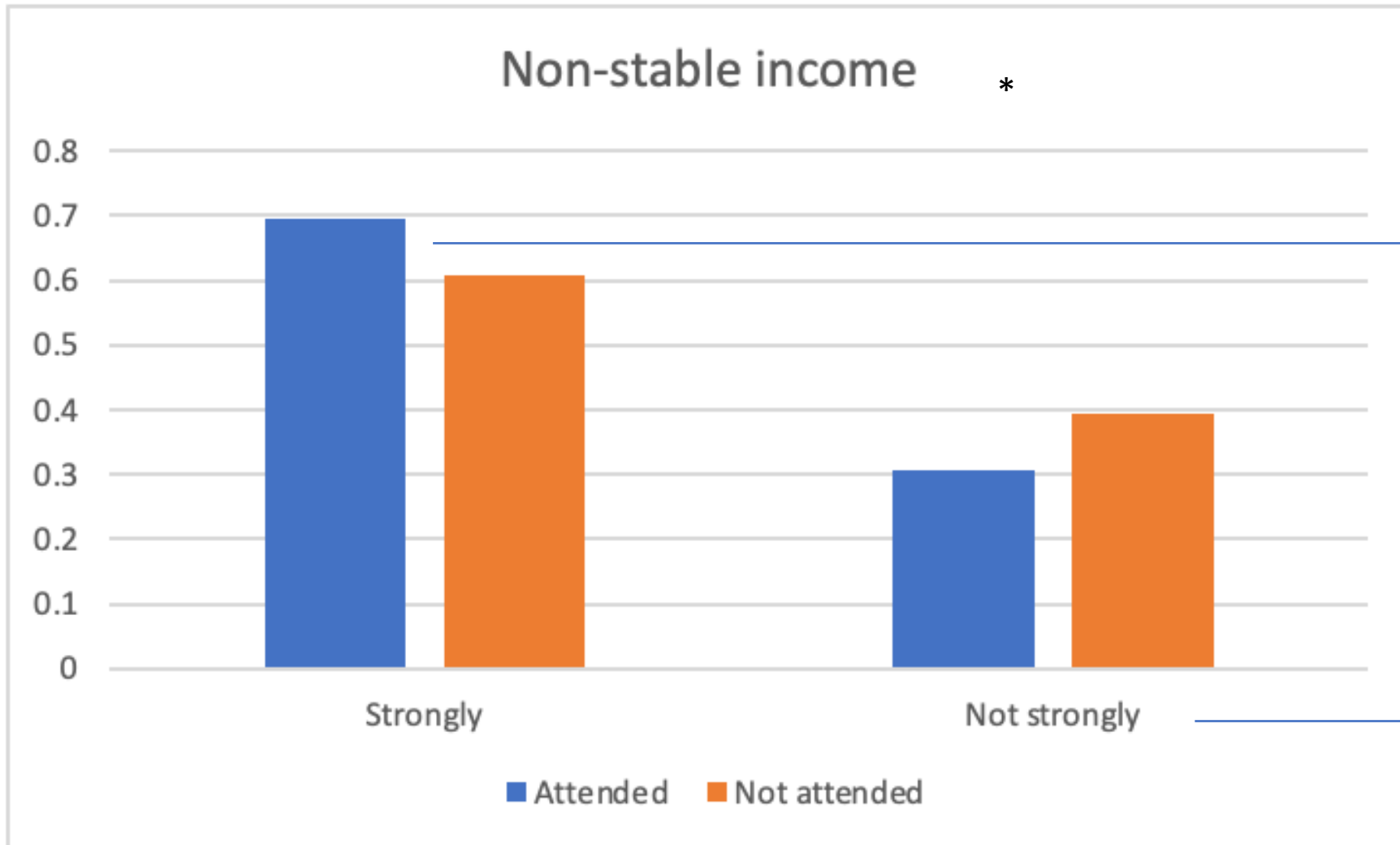
How strongly do you feel you belong to your local area



How strongly do you feel you belong to Coventry



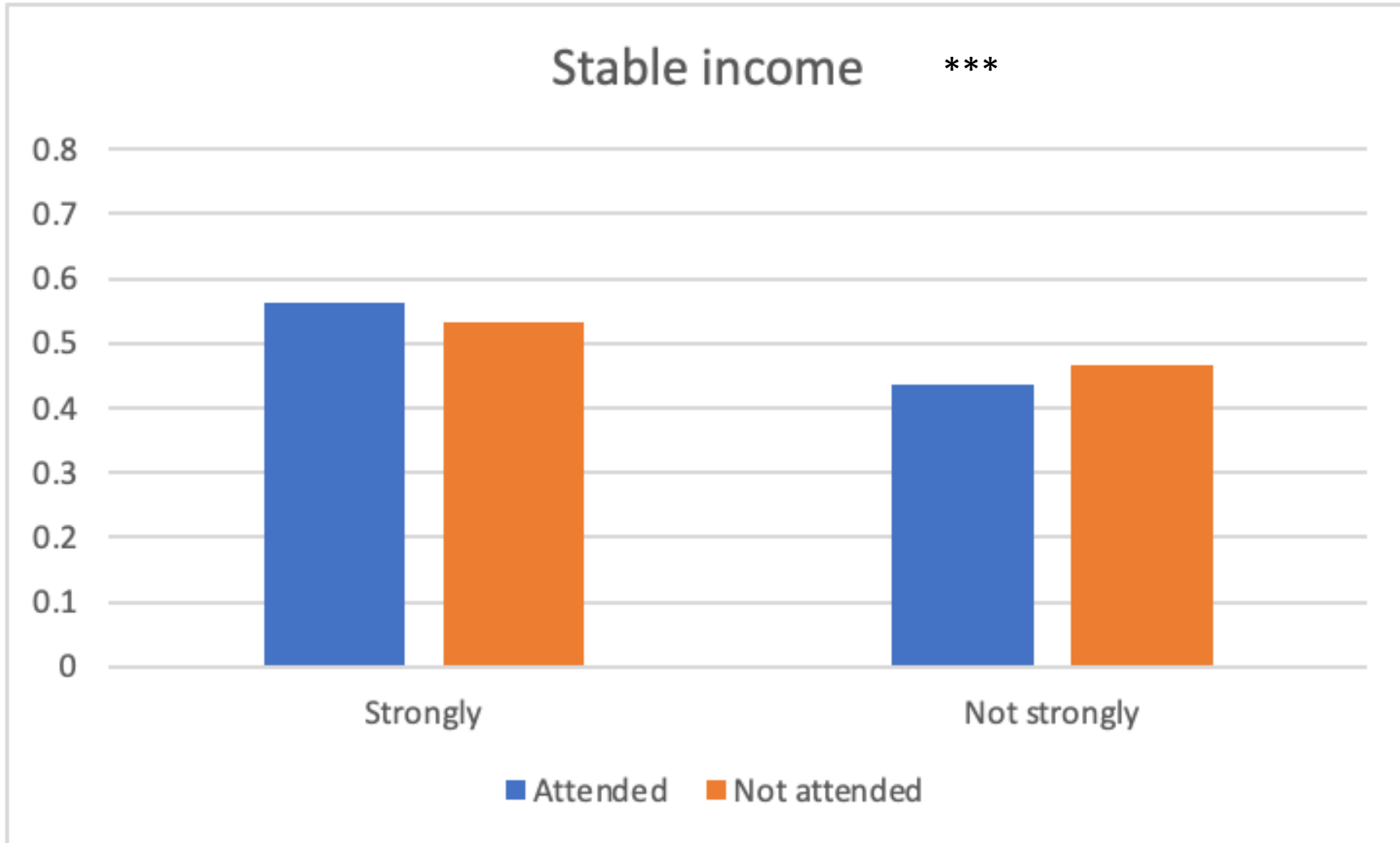

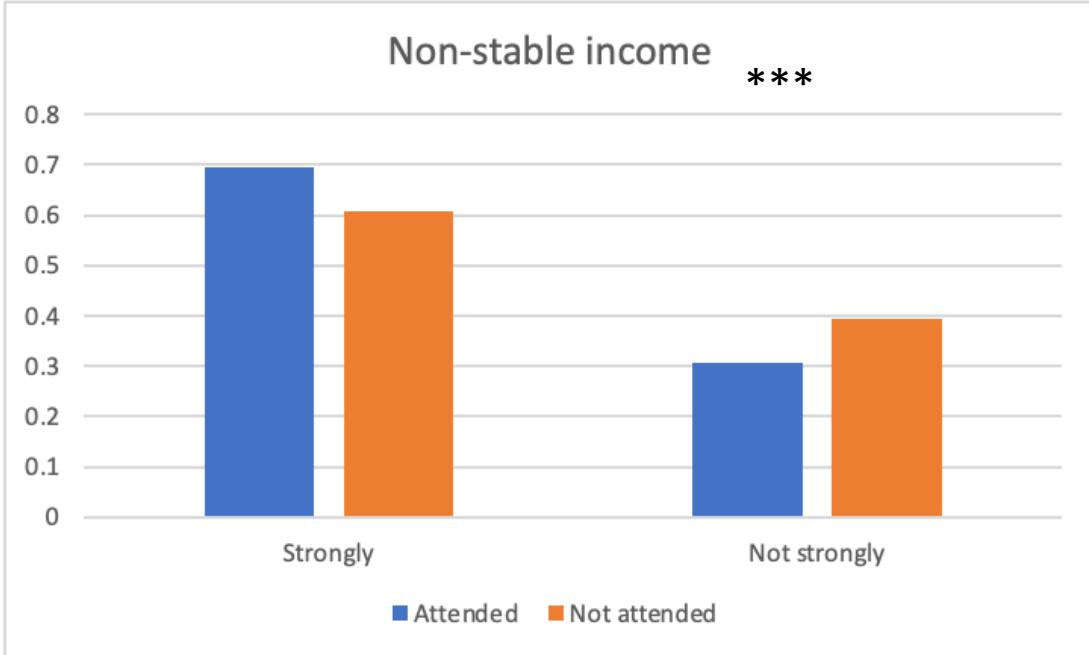
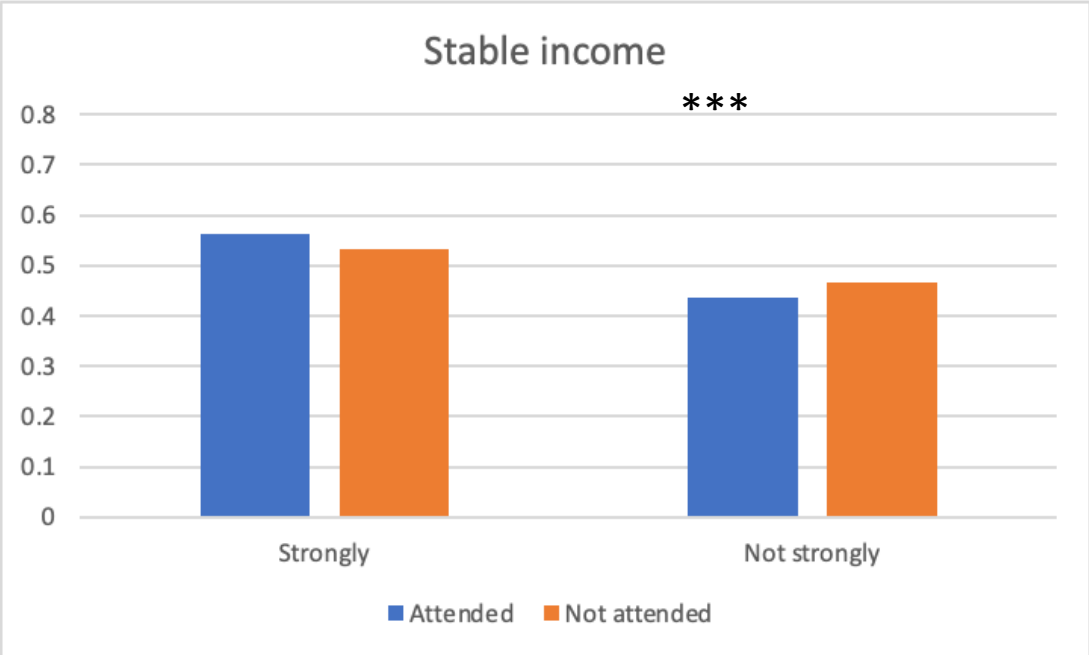
People who do not have a stable income to participate in the activities will be more helpful

People who don't have a stable income don't belong because it lacks opportunities to participate in activities

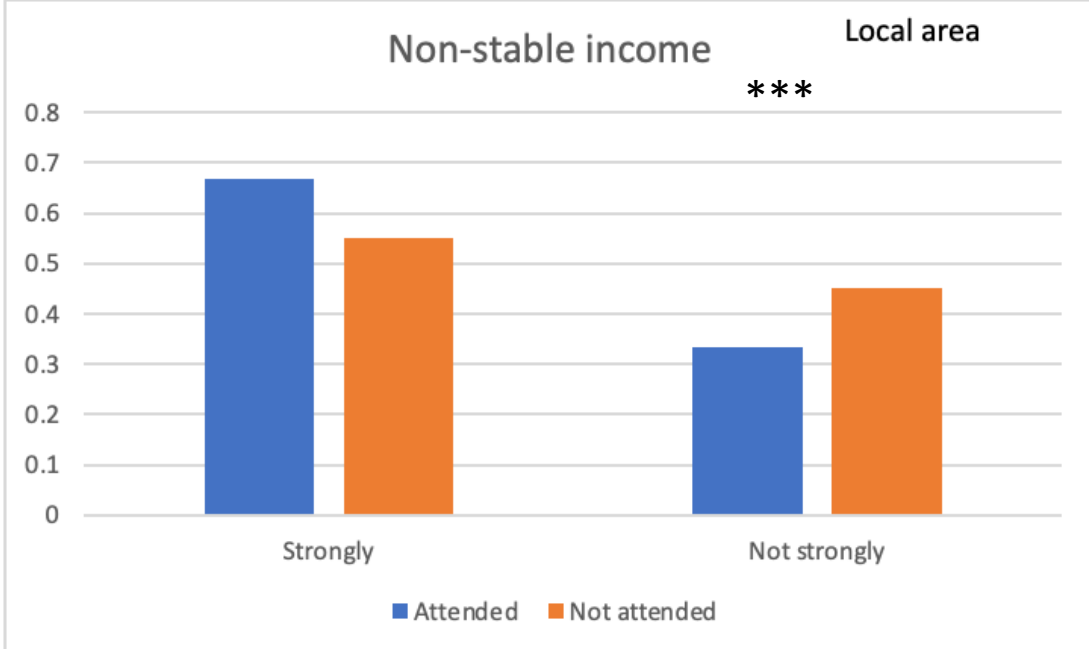
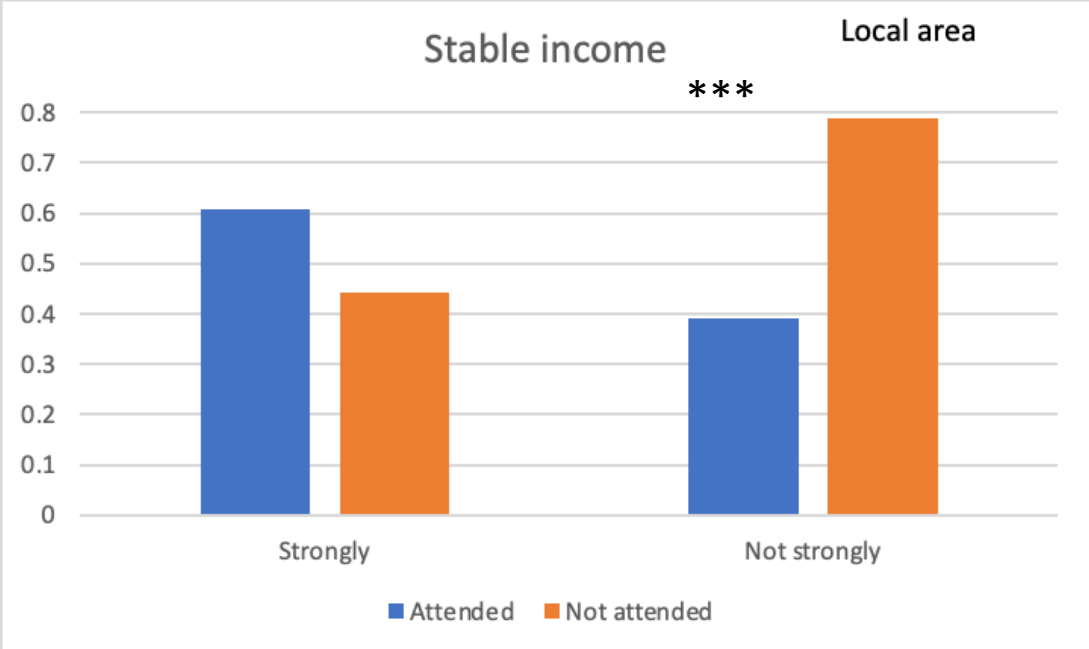
